FIELD MAINTENANCE INTERNSHIP

Program Overview: Field Maintenance Interns will have the opportunity to learn best practices of maintaining a professional baseball field and work in the following areas:

-mowing and watering the grass field and recognizing potential issues in the turf

-caring for the infield skin, including dragging, adding/removing/leveling turface, edging to keep nice lines of turf and removing/preventing lips from forming

-repairing the game mound, bullpen mounds and home plate areas

-working the warning track for edging, keeping weeds from developing and keeping level through dragging

-reading the weather to know when the tarp needs to be put on the field and taken off

-working with the field manager for batting practice needs

-Prepping the field for the game

Qualifications/Requirements:

-A desire to explore a career in baseball field maintenance

-The drive to make this internship your TOP priority during the summer.

-Interns MUST be available to work for the duration of the internship program.

-The ability to work as part of a team

-Strong customer service skills

Field Maintenance interns will report directly to the General Manager while also working with other staff members. The Field Maintenance Internship is a paid position while also being eligible to earn school credit if desired.
