About the Sea Unicorns: The Norwich Sea Unicorns are a collegiate summer league baseball team in the Futures Collegiate Baseball League (FCBL) based in Norwich, Connecticut. The Sea Unicorns focus on providing an entertaining experience for fans, with community events and family-friendly activities for those in Norwich and the surrounding areas. The Sea Unicorns play their home games at the historic Senator Thomas J. Dodd Memorial Stadium.

JOB DESCRIPTION

This position is a seasonal internship that will provide an in-depth experience into the game day revenue departments of the Norwich Sea Unicorns baseball club, as well as the operations of the ballpark.

This position will work closely with the Director of Concessions and Ticket Operations, along with the rest of the Sea Unicorns Front Office Staff to be an integral part of a successful 31-game season. This part-time internship will run from mid-May through mid-August and entails approximately 30-40 hours per week.

MAIN DUTIES

1. Assist in Operation of Game Day Box Office Operations

- Assist in oversight of all aspects of the Box Office operation
- Assist in the training and scheduling of seasonal Box Office Staff
- Assist with ticket sales and customer inquiries via phone, email, and in-person
- Provide excellent customer service to all fans
- Assist in revenue reporting and end of game bank drops from the ticketing department

2. Assist in Operation of Concessions Department

- Assist in all aspects of the food & beverage operation
- Assist in the training and scheduling of seasonal concessions staff
- Assist to ensure all menu items, pricing, and COG are up to date and accurate in point of sale system
- Understand all aspects of the point of sale system including front end sales, suite sales, and menu building
- Check each stand after events to ensure cleanliness
- Stress health and safety measures and enforce rules on seasonal concessions employees
- Provide excellent customer service to all fans
- Assist in revenue reporting and end of game bank drops from the concessions department
- Assist in oversight picnics, birthday parties and other outside events

3. Assist in the Merchandise and Parking Departments

- Assist in oversight of Merchandise Store seasonal staff
- Assist in cleanliness and stocking of merchandise store
- Assist in oversight of the online merchandise store
- Understand all aspects of the parking operation and be able to assist in the general parking operation
- Assist in revenue reporting and end of game bank drops from the merchandise and parking departments
- Assist with design and basic layout of merchandise products and the organization and cleanliness of the merchandise store
